## **Soccer/Volleyball Rules Meeting Info**

From Email received from Rick Ulreich:

A couple of items from the soccer / volleyball playoff meeting.

- 1) We got quite a few high compliments on the playoff and not just from the members of the executive board.
- 2) They want to start having all soccer playoff officials attend the playoff meeting.
- 3 Voted at meeting - still to be approved by the executive boards - allow free changes at the time of an injury if the injured player comes off the field. All players that are to be subed in must already be at the center line. Currently the rule is only one player by the opposing team if the injured player comes off.
- 4) Need to get the pastor to sign off on rosters or have the pastor write a letter saying they give approval to a member of the athletic association.
- 5) Volleyball votes passed to be approved by executive board - a) eliminate the 15 subs maximum and make it unlimited b) matching shorts, and the undershirt must match the dominant color of the uniform will become mandatory in the playoffs.
- 6) The following will need to be put in writing and will be voted on at next years meeting for the 2012 volleyball season. a) allow A league managers to choose before the game starts if they want us use the player for player substitution or use standard rotation. b) rule change for 6th grade girls to switch to the volleylite instead of the regular volleyball.

## Rule Change Proposals

### Proposal #1

By-Laws Rule X Forfeitures:

Add to Section 1

Should a team drop from a league within the first 2 weeks of the schedule, a new schedule shall be made to provide a full complement of games for the remaining teams. All games played or forfeited by the dropped team will be nullified and the team will not be charged a forfeit fee. All other games, played or forfeited, shall stand as recorded. NOTE: a new 3 team league shall be incorporated with another league.

### Proposal #2

E-mail voting

Proposal: To make e-mail voting an acceptable voting source for unique items that come up outside of the monthly EBM meeting. The following guidelines are to be followed.

- 1) The chairman shall call for an e-mail vote and the vice chairman / secretary shall send out the e-mail explaining the details of what is to be voted on and will collect the responses.
- 2) The voting time period shall last for 72 hours or until all viable voting members have responded with their vote.
- 3) After 48 hours the vice chairman / secretary (the one who sends out the original e-mail) shall call those that have not responded and remind them that their vote is due within 24 hours.
- 4) A total of 75% of the voting participants must respond for the vote to be official.
- 5) A majority is all that is needed for the vote to be passed.
- 6) Upon final results of the e-mail vote, the vice chairman / secretary shall report at the next EBM meeting the results so it can be documented in the meeting minutes.
- 7) This vote can not be used for items that result in constitution and / or bylaw changes, along with a dollar limitation of \$500.

Reason for proposal: Due to the complexity of getting members together for a brief meeting due to timing, schedule conflicts and other items, along with the advancement of today's society, it is time for the NCCYC to adapt to a more modern form of communication. This could be a resolution to resolving brief and simple votes that could create a more accurate vote compared to a sudden formal meeting when members are not able to attend.

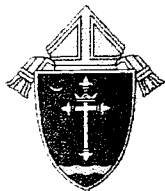
### Saturday, June 25
