**CYC RESPONSE TO FEE**  
**Email sent to Rick Ulreich and Dan Callan**

Rick,

Sorry to have taken awhile to get back to you on this. As you know from what was discussed at the Executive Meetings of November 2009, February 2010, March 2010, fees were going to be increased to cover each district's share of the Archdiocesan Agency Management Fee which was now going to have to be charged to each district. From discussions at the meetings, the other district's fees were raised with the 2010 baseball/softball seasons. With your set-up, North County's fees were not raised, as the past agreement called for fees to be raised with the soccer/volleyball seasons.

The increase that was included in the fees for the 2010 soccer/volleyball seasons was \$4.00. The \$4.00 raise was consistent with what the increases in the past have been. If you recall from the discussions the other districts were raised \$10.00 per team.

My delay in responding was due to the holidays and trying to get figures from the Archdiocesan Finance Office. I was trying to get what the Archdiocesan Agency Management Fee would be for the North County District. Again if you recall from those earlier discussions the figures being used by them would be basically 2 years behind, so we are talking the numbers from 2009. The figure given to me as your revenue for the 2009 year was \$160,348.55. Taking 3% of that, the management fee would be \$4810.00. If our numbers are correct for the 2009, we show you having 286 teams in 2009 (**Dan's Note - See Attachment 5 Agenda**), which I believe comes out to \$16.82 per team. Higher than I would have thought. Higher than what our proposed fee increases were.

Please discuss this with your district and advise as to how you want to proceed. If you want, we can probably have the Finance Office bill this to you directly.

# NORTH COUNTY CYC ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION LEPAGE/GRAHAM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## I. Purpose:

Award at least one boy and one girl each a \$500.00 scholarship for their higher education. To be awarded annually at the June Executive Board Meeting.

## II. Qualifications:

- A. Presently an eighth grade student.
- B. Participated in good standing in the NCCYCAA Sports Program for at least three years, including the current year. (Exception to the current year requirement is for medical reasons only.)
- C. Must submit a letter of recommendation from your current school teacher or principal.
- D. You must be nominated by your Parish Athletic Committee.
- E. A letter of recommendation from the Parish Pastor or religious leader must accompany your application to the NCCYCAA.

## III. Operation:

- A. Each Parish within the NCCYCAA is encouraged to submit the name of two boys and two girls to be considered for the Scholarship.
- B. A Scholarship Selection Committee consisting of three members, appointed by the NCCYC Chairman, will select a pre-determined number of names of boys and girls from all submitted applications to be awarded the scholarships. It is recommended that one new member of the Scholarship Selection Committee be appointed each year.
- C. The following schedule is recommended:
  1. All names submitted on or before the May Executive Board Meeting be given to the Scholarship Selection Committee.
  2. The Scholarship Selection Committee will submit the list of names at the June Meeting. At this time, the Executive Board will vote to adopt the recommendations of the committee and approve the final list of recipients.
  3. The Awards will be given to the winners at the July Executive Board Meeting.
- D. The Award will be paid directly to the School of choice. If the school is to be a college, the money will be put into a NCCYCAA savings account in the winners name for up to five years. If the money is not used in that time it will be returned to the NCCYCAA general funds.
